Nurse's Notes

February is National Heart Month.

A woman has a heart attack every 90 seconds in the United States. If you think you or someone you know is having a heart attack, call staff or 9-1-1 immediately. The good news is that if you seek help quickly, treatment can save your life and prevent permanent damage to your heart muscle. Treatment works best if given within 1 hour of when symptoms begin.

Common Symptoms are:

- Unusually heavy pressure on chest
- Sharp upper body pain in neck, back, and jaw
- Severe shortness of breath
- Cold sweats (not hot flashes)
